

15 Ways You Can Help Raise Funds to Support Tri-County United Way

1. Dinner Party with a Donation

Host a themed dinner or potluck and ask guests to make a donation in lieu of bringing food or gifts. You can include a short presentation or video about Tri-County United Way's mission.

2. Backyard Movie Night

Partner with a local vendor or use your own selection to host a tasting event. Guests can make a donation to sample and enjoy a casual evening while supporting Tri-County United Way.

9. Fitness or Wellness Class

Offer a yoga, meditation, or fitness class in your home or backyard. You can lead it yourself if you're qualified or invite a local instructor to volunteer their time for a good cause.

10. Themed Costume or Trivia Party

Choose a fun theme (like decades, pop culture, or holidays) and invite guests to dress up. Include a trivia contest or costume competition, with an entry fee supporting Tri-County United Way.

11. Silent Auction Night

Gather donated items or services (like homemade crafts, gift baskets, or local business vouchers) and host a silent auction in your home. Guests write bids on sheets, and the highest bidder wins — with all proceeds going to Tri-County United Way.

12. Storytelling or Book Club Event

Set up a decorative tree or bulletin board with tags representing donation amounts or specific needs supported by Tri-County United Way (e.g., "\$25 = school supplies for a child"). Guests can choose a tag to donate and feel a tangible connection to the cause.
